



General Information and Rules

- The event is scheduled at 09:30 AM on September 20, 2019 at D.Y. Patil University, Sector 7. Nerul, Navi Mumbai.
- Only Under Graduate Final Year B. Tech/ BE- Biotechnology, Food technology and Chemical engineering students or First Year Post graduate students. **There is no participation fee.**
- Each college can nominate **only one student** for the contest.
- The participant selected by the college has to be nominated for the event in the prescribed '**Nomination form**' duly signed by the HOD.
- Duly filled nomination form should be scanned and sent to pavanapr@ableindia.org.in & indrilas@ableindia.org.in. The '**Nomination form**' should be emailed to us on or before **September 05, 2019**.
- Participants should reach the venue at 08:00AM and must bring his/her ID card along with the **original nomination form** for the registration.
- 3 topics will be sent to the nominated participant, 3 days prior to the event, to prepare. The organizers will decide on the topic for the participant to speak on the day of the event
- Each participant gets a time limit of 5 minutes (4+1) to speak
- Participants will not be permitted to use Power Point presentations/notes/audio visuals during the contest
- **For outstation participants:**
 - Participant's travel costs will be reimbursed only upon submission of tickets/bills. Please note that the amount of reimbursement shall be limited/equivalent to the cost of a 3 Tier A/ C train ticket fare only.
 - Participant's accommodation request should be sent in advance to the organizers for consideration. The accommodation is subject to availability at the host college.
- In the event of cancellation of the program, due to any unforeseen circumstances, the program will be held at a later date. The colleges/participants will be informed about the same.
